Massimo Mucchetti



Born in Brescia on 12 December 1953, married, one daughter. In 1973, at age of nineteen, Massimo Mucchetti began his journalistic activities with some friends and founded a local monthly, *L'Altra Brescia*, in order to break the information monopoly of the *Giornale di Brescia*, controlled by the two local banks, the Banca San Paolo and the Credito Agrario Bresciano.

He worked for the *Sole 24 Ore* editorial group, the weekly *L'Espresso* and *Corriere della Sera*. Three books, all with *Feltrinelli* publishing company: *Licenziare i Padroni?* (Lay off the bosses?) in 2003; *Il baco del Corriere* (The Corriere's bug) in 2006 and *Confiteor, intervista con Cesare Geronzi*, (Confiteor, interview with Cesare Geronzi) in 2012.

He is currently the **Chairman** of the Standing Committee on **Industry, Commerce and Tourism** of the **Italian Senate**. As Italian senator he is in charge of important industrial and economical dossiers, including the case **Ilva** steel company crisis, **Telecom Italia** and strategies and results of State-owned companies as **Eni, Enel, Terna** and **Finmeccanica**. He was also the first subscriber of a draft law on conflict of interest and incompatibilities of the members of the Parliament.
